
Fishbowl Spinner.

You will need thickish white paper or card from a cereal packet, felt tip pens and thread. Tape and glue.



1. Cut two squares from the paper (about 10cm), but they just need to be the same size.
On one square draw a bowl that fills the square. Decorate with pebbles and weeds.




5. Hold the ends of the thread. The spinner will hang down. Flip the picture over and over so the threads are twisted.

threads are completely twisted.

PULL the threads tight and see how the picture spins.



2. On the other square draw a fish in the middle.Cut two threads about 30cm long – they need to be the same length.



3. Turn over the square with the fish on. Tape the middle of the two threads across the square. Leave a gap between them as big as your finger.



4. Stick the two pictures together back to back. IT IS IMPORTANT the bowl is the right way round, but the fish is UPSIDE DOWN.



It looks as if the fish is now inside the bowl. The picture is spinning so fast your eyes can't see each picture and your brain merges them together.
