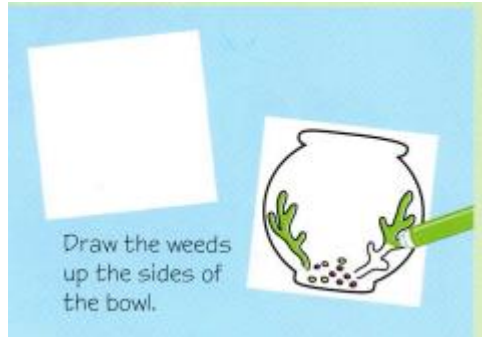


Fishbowl Spinner.

You will need thickish white paper or card from a cereal packet, felt tip pens and thread. Tape and glue.



1. Cut two squares from the paper (about 10cm), but they just need to be the same size. On one square draw a bowl that fills the square. Decorate with pebbles and weeds.



2. On the other square draw a fish in the middle.



3. Turn over the square with the fish on. Tape the middle of the two threads across the square. Leave a gap between them as big as your finger.

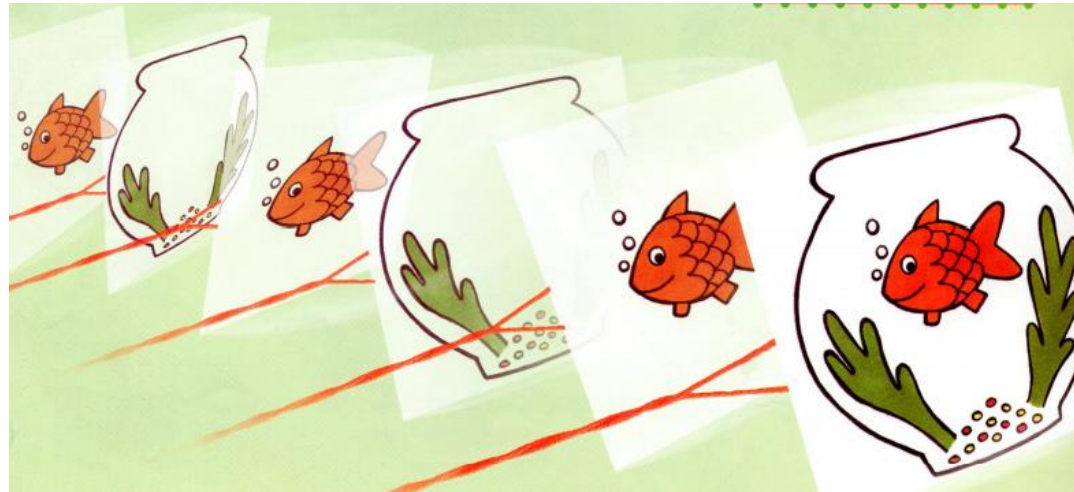


4. Stick the two pictures together back to back. IT IS IMPORTANT the bowl is the right way round, but the fish is UPSIDE DOWN.



5. Hold the ends of the thread. The spinner will hang down. Flip the picture over and over so the threads are twisted.

PULL the threads tight and see how the picture spins.



It looks as if the fish is now inside the bowl. The picture is spinning so fast your eyes can't see each picture and your brain merges them together.
