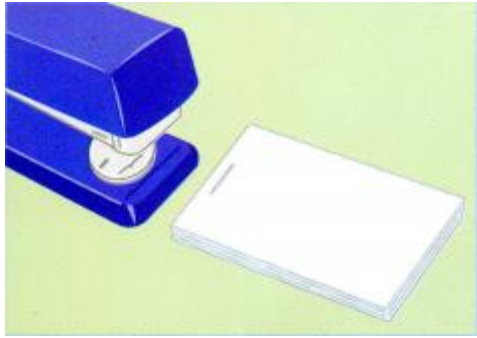
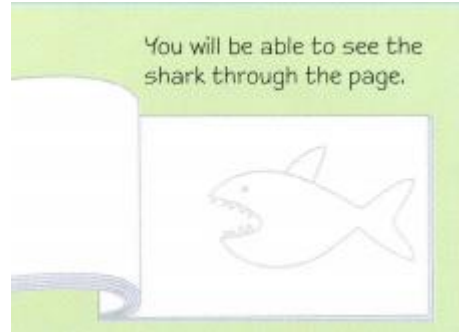


Shark Flick book

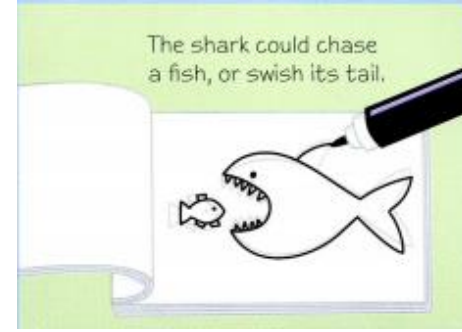
You will need two pieces of thin paper, a black pen and a stapler or clip/sellotape..



1. Cut fourteen pieces of thin white paper. They need to be the same size. (If you use 2 pieces of paper and fold each one into 8 to cut up, this will be enough.)
Pile them all up and staple them at the end (or clip them together.)



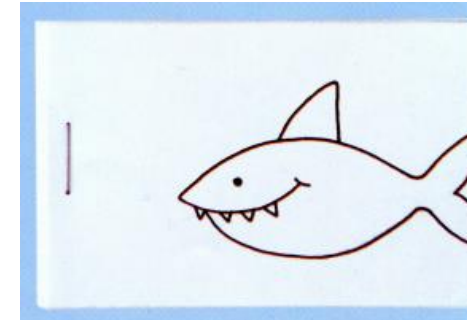
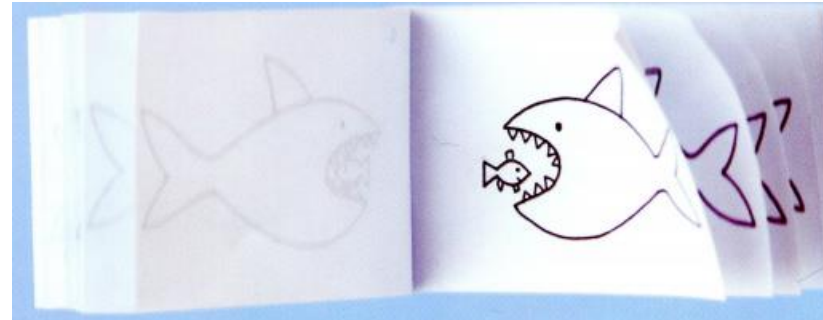
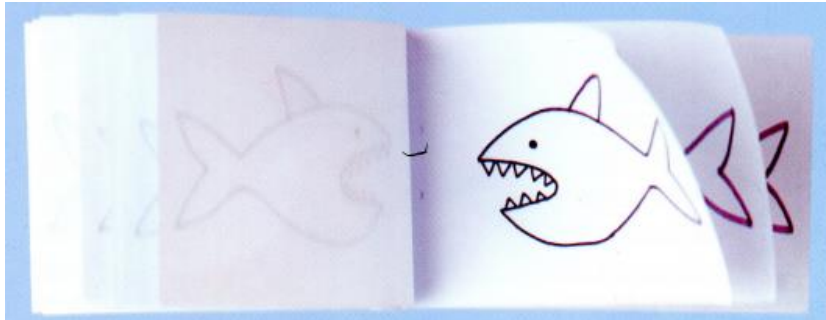
2. Using a pencil draw a picture of a shark on the **back** page of the book. Turn down the next page so it covers the shark.



3. Draw over the outline, but change it a little, so the shark 'moves' slightly.
Keep turning the page down in front and drawing over the shark. Each time 'move' the shark a little.



4. Hold the flick book like this, then flick through all the pictures from the BACK to the FRONT. The shark will look like it's moving.



As you flick the pages, your eyes and brain put the pictures together so it looks like the shark is moving.
