1. How many banana cupcakes were sold? 48
2. How many strawberry cupcakes were sold? 64
3. Which was the most popular flavour of cupcake? (Which one sold the most?) Chocolate
4. Which was the least popular flavour of cupcake? (Which one sold the least?) Orange

Challenge question: How many more strawberry cupcakes than orange cupcakes were sold? $64-24=40$

2 This bar graph shows the number of chicken pies sold in the same café from Monday to Friday.

(a) 74 chicken pies were sold on Monday and Tuesday altogether.
(b) The most chicken pies were sold on Friday and the least number of chicken pies were sold on Tuesday.

24 m more chicken pies were sold on Thursday than on Wednesday.
(d) Which was a more popular choice in the café, the burgers (Question 1) or the chicken pies? Explain your answer.
