
We have been looking at fact files about the Queen, now, I think it's time we had a go at writing a fact file about someone we know really well. Go and find an adult. Ask them if you can do a fact file about them. If they are busy, you could do a fact file about yourself!

But how are you going to do it?



If you remember the Queen's fact file, you will know it needs to be organized into sections, with a heading for each section.



Each of the headings in **bold** could be used in your own fact file.

You might also want to draw a picture of them.

If you still have time, you might want to add to your fact file. Here are some suggestions for other headings you could use.

Early life.

What school they went to and the subjects they enjoyed at school.

Occupation/duties

What job they have and the kinds of things they have to do.

Favourite food or style of cooking.

What they like to eat or if they like Mexican food or Chinese food.

Hobbies and interests.

What they like to do or places they like to go in their spare time.

Fun facts.

Anything they can tell you about themselves that is different, or something you did not know.

You can probably think of better ones!

You will still need... *Capital letters to start a sentence and for names of people and places. *Full stops or exclamation marks to finish a sentence.

* Neat handwriting with finger spaces.

* Fred fingers for spellings.
