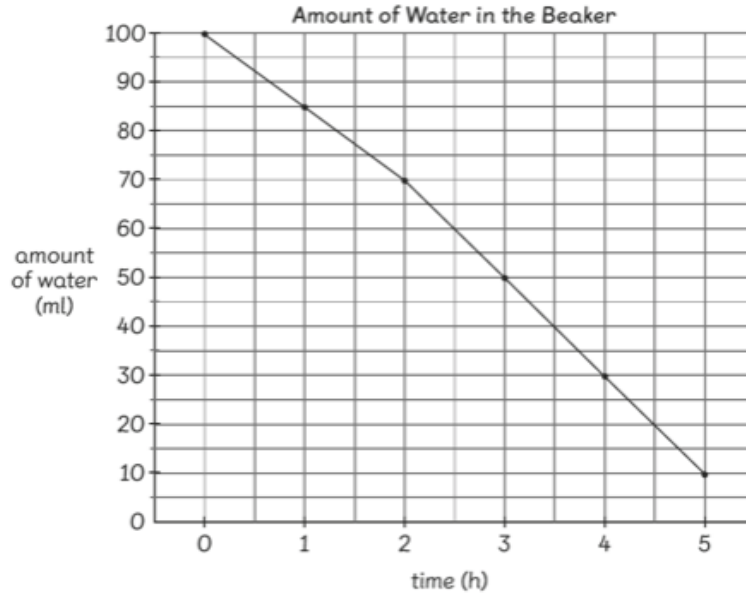


- 3 Another beaker of water was left to evaporate for 5 hours. The amount of water in the beaker was also recorded hourly.
