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3. *'They gave Red a cup of tea and told her about the good old days... when there were endless miles of forest to run through and a thousand tasty grazing beasts to bite... when the world was awash with flowers and bees and dripping with honey... when you could just lie on a branch and wait for lunch to wander right under your paws.'*

How does it make them to feel to hear that description? What did they picture in their minds?

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4. Look at the tiny tree saplings on the windowsill with the animals looking in. How do you think those animals are feeling? What might they think of Red's plan?  

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
