TASK: I would like you to create your own 'fake' competition post or news story. Remember it is fake... it can be as crazy as you want it to be!



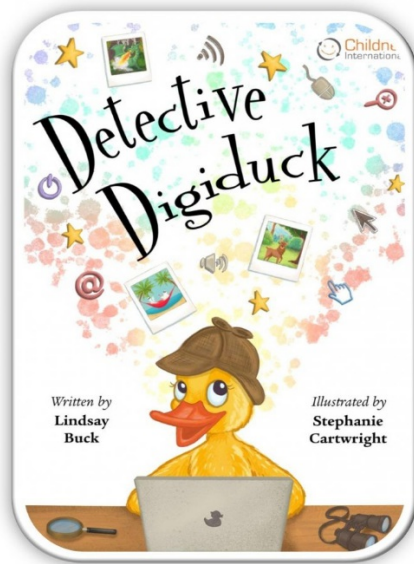
What would you do if you were not sure whether to trust something online?

“Before you enter an online competition, ask an adult you trust for help.”

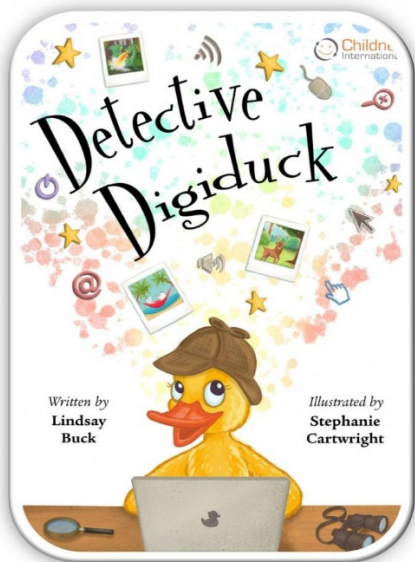
Listen to the story Detective Digiduck!
