There's No Such Thing As A Nessie.

Watch the video of the story again. Use it to fill in this grid. To do it in your book, or on paper, divide the page into 4 and put a heading in each section. This is just about what YOU think about the story, so there are no right/wrong answers.

<u>Likes</u>

This is for anything you liked in the story – this could be illustrations, characters, the things characters did, if it made you laugh, any words you particularly liked.

<u>Puzzles</u>

This is to ask questions about the story – things you did not understand. You might want to know more about the Loch Ness Monster. You might want to know why there was a submarine in the loch. You might want to know why the sister was so unkind.

<u>Dislikes</u>

This is for anything you did not like in the story. You may not have liked some of the illustrations or some of the characters. You may not have liked the monster itself or thought it could have been scarier/larger/more real.

Patterns

Do you know of any other stories or films which are similar to this one? Does the story remind you of anything? Do you know of any films or stories where someone finds a monster, or has a secret monster they live with. Maybe a story where a child is not believed when they say they have seen a monster.
