**Statement, question, exclamation command**

**Statement**

A statement tells the reader a fact or point about something.

Statements end in a full stop.

They can be simple, complex or compound sentences.

**question**

A question asks the reader something.

Questions end in a ? and have a question word at the start of the sentence.

**exclamation**

An exclamation sentence is used to make the reader think WOW that sounds great.

Exclamations end with a !

They usually start with how or what. Be careful these are question words and exclamation words.

**command**

Starts with a verb.

! to end with.

## Question

Ask a question. Use a question mark ? At the end of a sentence to show that you are asking a question.

**Why** is your bedroom so messy?

**command**

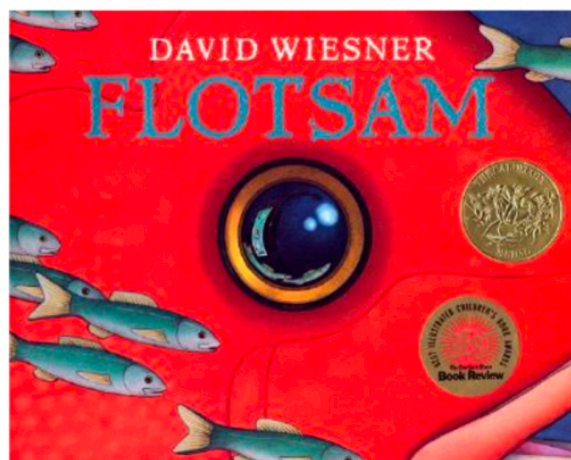
**question**

# Command
