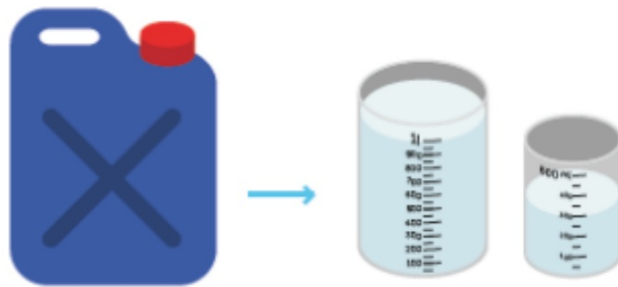

Is there more than 1 litre of water in the container?

How could I write this?

Let's Learn

This is 1 litre of water.



This is another 300 ml of water.



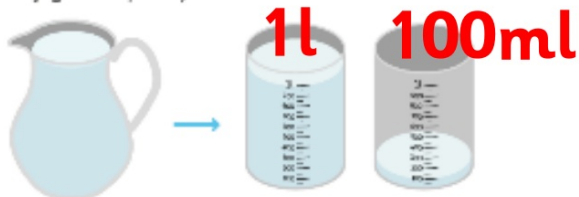
The container holds 1 l 300 ml of water.
It is more than 1 litre.

2 How much water is there in the fish bowl?



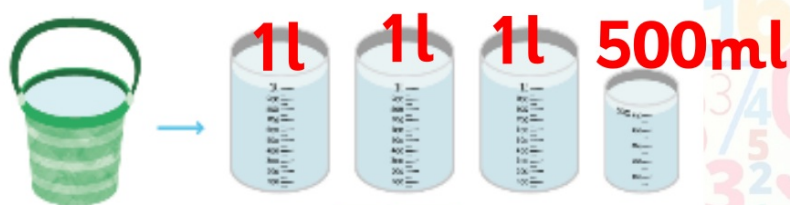
The volume of water in the bowl is l ml.

3 The jug is completely filled with water.



The capacity of the jug is l ml.

4 How much water is there in the bucket?



The volume of water in the bucket is l ml.

We are now going to convert those measures into just ml.

There are 1000ml in 1L.

So...

$$1\text{L } 300\text{ml} = \text{th h t o } 1300\text{ml}$$
