We are going to look at the Hindu story of Ramayana.



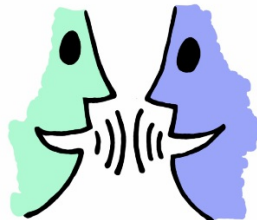


Who was good in this story?
