A statement tells the reader a fact or gives advice something.	A question asks the reader something.	An exclamation expresses a fact or tells the reader how you feel strongly about something.	Starts with a verb.
Statements end in a full stop.	Questions end in a ? and have a question word at the start of the sentence.	Exclamations end with a !	They end with .
They can be simple, compound or compound sentences.		They usually start with how or when. All capital letters are spelling words and exclamation words.
