Tommy buys the car because $£ 4.65$ rounds to $£ 5$ and he will get change from $£ 5$.

Eva buys the panda because this costs $£ 3.05$ which is 5 p more than $£ 3.00$. $£ 3.05$ rounds to £3.

Amir buys the rugby ball and the space card because $£ 13.83$ rounds to $£ 20$ and $£ 5.45$ rounds to $£ 5 . £ 20+£ 5=£ 25$

If I had $£ 30$, I would by the panda. I would get approximately $£ 27$ of change because $£ 3.05$ rounds to $£ 3 . £ 30-£ 3=£ 27$.
