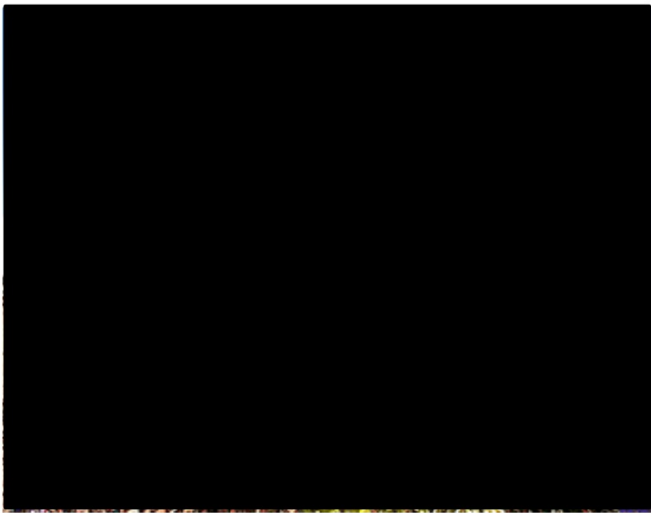

What is the weather like in these countries?



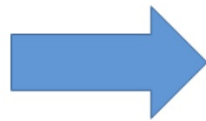
60% of the world's cocoa is from two countries in West Africa - Cote d'Ivoire and Ghana.



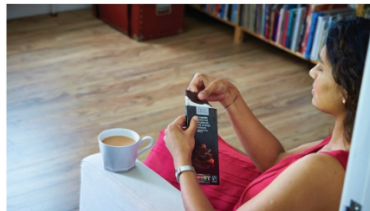
What is the weather like in these countries?

We need to think about the journey of our chocolate from cocoa beans to supermarket shelves.



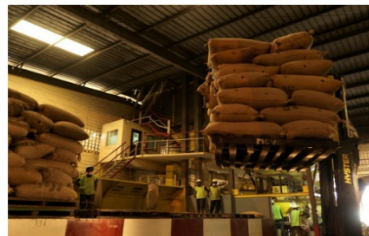
This is a cocoa pod and a chocolate bar. Think about how the cocoa pod becomes the chocolate bars that we like to eat.
