What did the 20th century bring to Britain?

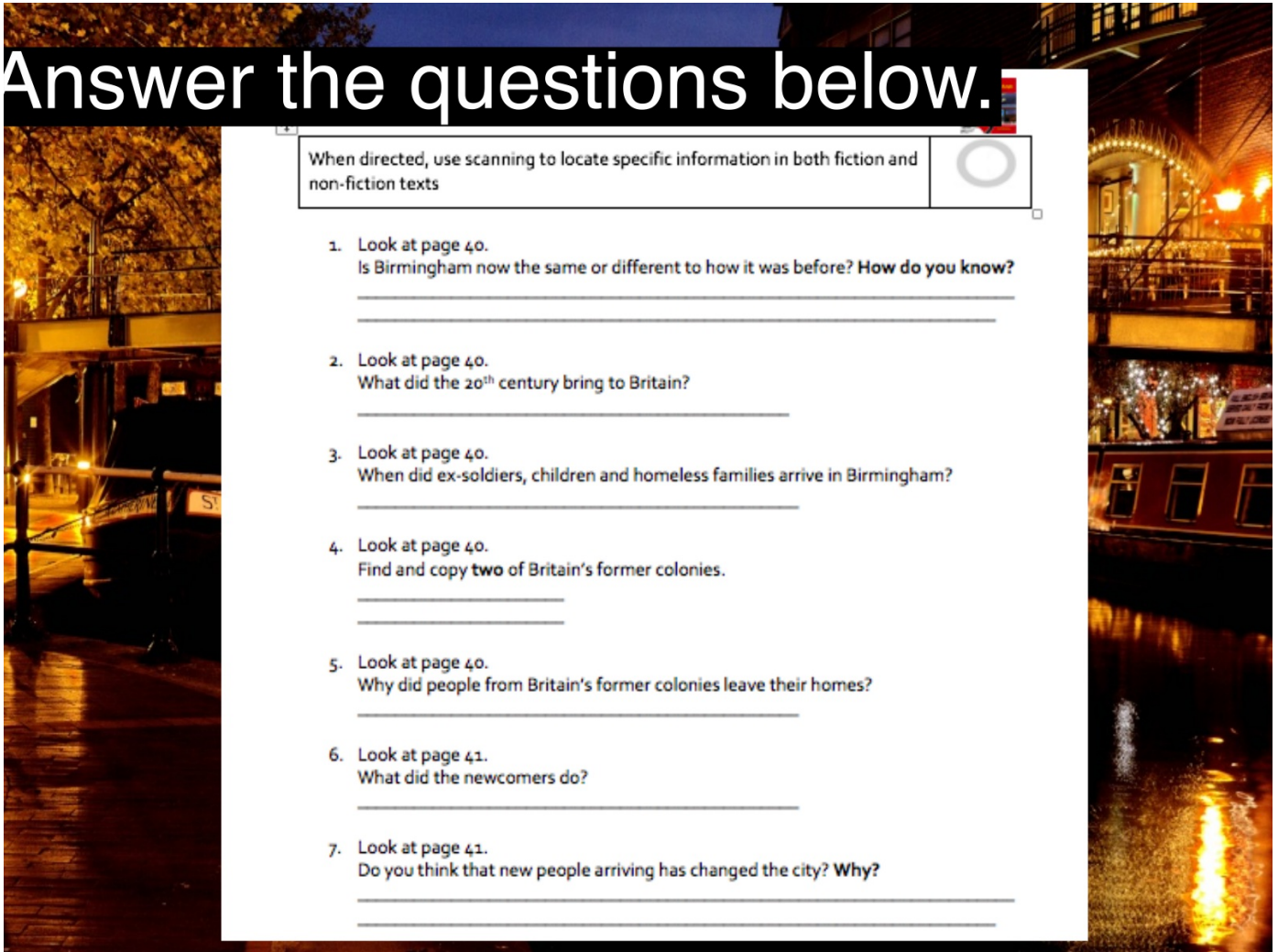
3. Look at page 40.
