Question Two (1 Mark)

1 mark for circling the correct response

Question Three (1 Mark)

1 mark for discussing the meaning accurately

E.g. The unjust treatment of different categories of people.

Question Four (1 Mark)

1 mark for circling the correct response

escalated

Question Five (1 Mark)

1 mark for the following phrase

'...where Anne would go for some solitude.'

Question Six (1 Mark)

1 mark for all definitions matched correctly

hardship – severe suffering

grief – feelings of intense sorrow

negativity – an expression of criticism or pessimism

defeated – demoralised or overcome



Question Seven (2 Marks)

2 marks for two of the following phrases

'remained positive.'

'...she continued to believe and have faith.'

'...her strength and her courage'

Question Eight (2 Marks)

1 mark for discussing the meaning accurately

E.g. Anne and her work will remain famous

2 marks for a more developed explanation using evidence from the text
