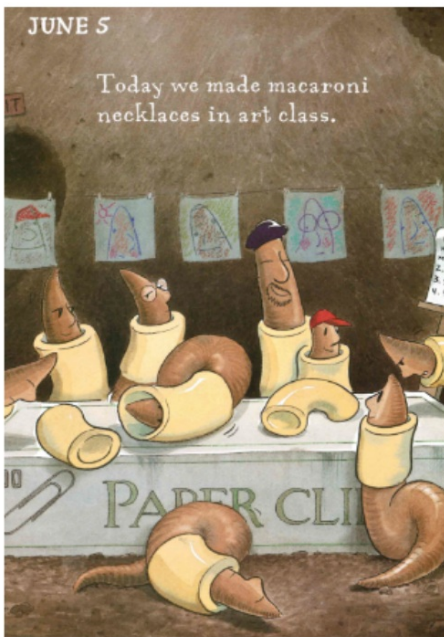


Today you are going to be worm and create another diary entry for a new day.

What person will you have to write in?



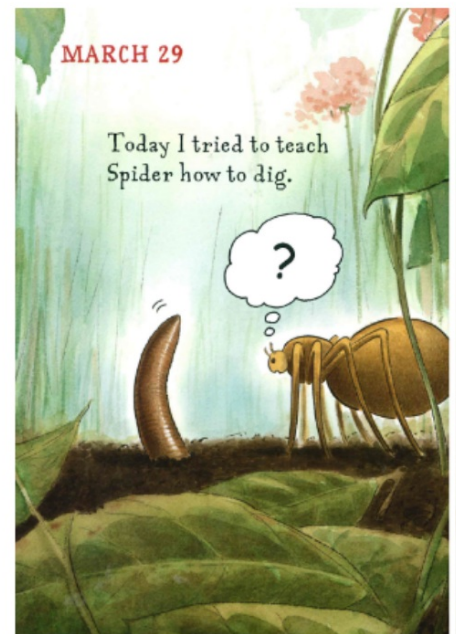
Your diary entry might be about another day at school. What might have worm done? What lesson could you talk about? Could something funny have happened?
